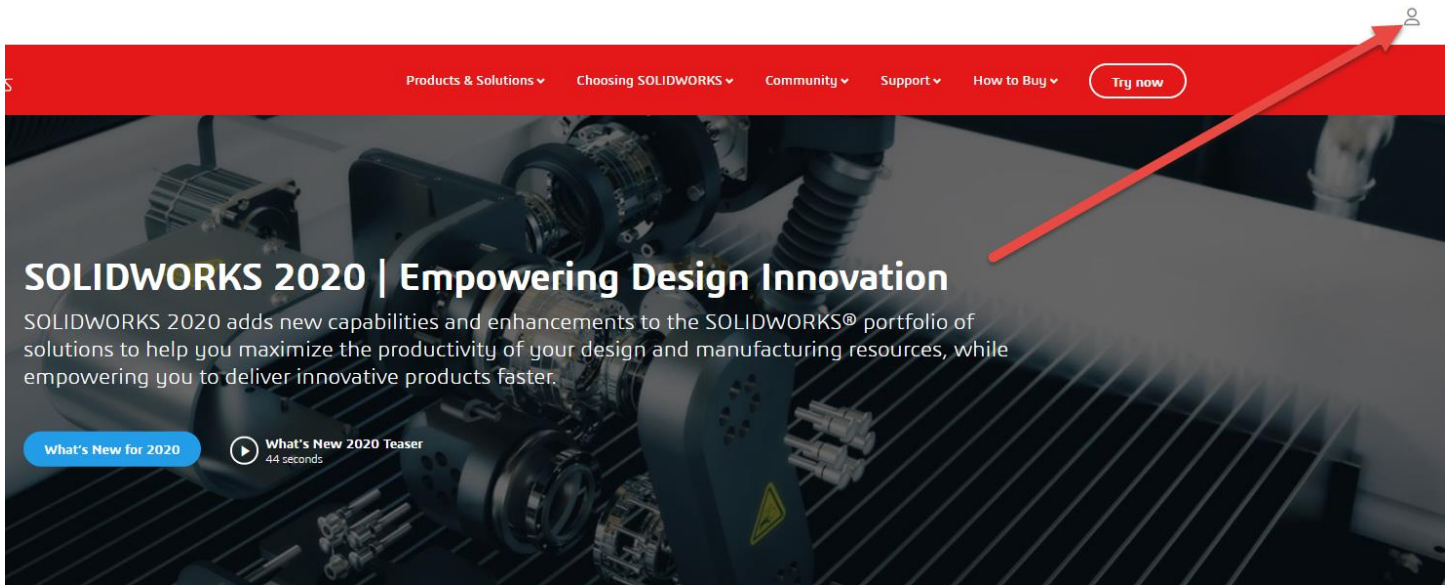
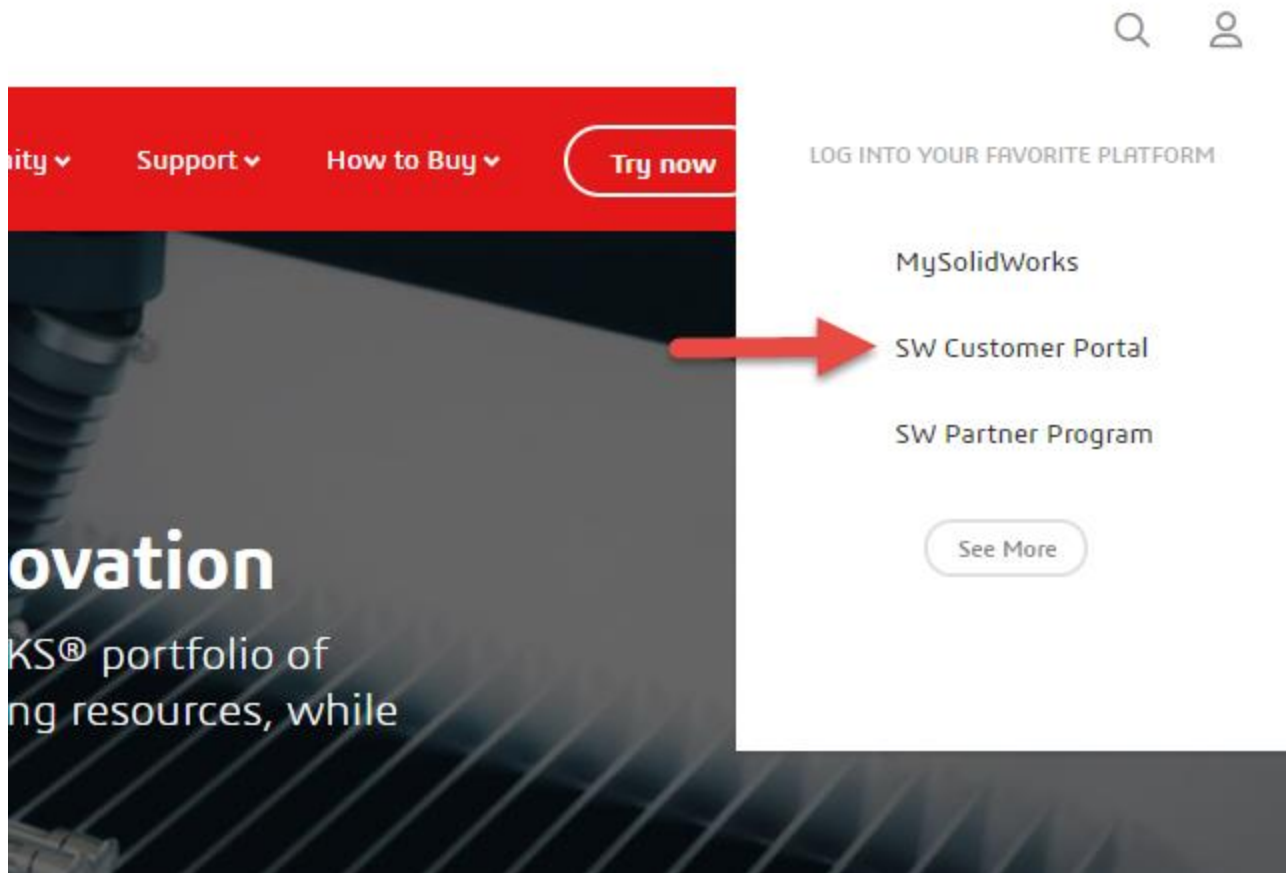


## SOLIDWORKS Installation Guide (Standalone License)


1. Navigate to [www.solidworks.com](http://www.solidworks.com) and select the profile icon on the top right of the page. If you are installing using a media DVD, insert the disk and skip to step 13.



2. On the dialog box that pops up select SW Customer Portal.



3. Click on **Create a SOLIDWORKS ID**. If you already have a customer portal account, login with your credentials and then skip to step 7 below.



4. Enter your company email address and SOLIDWORKS serial number.

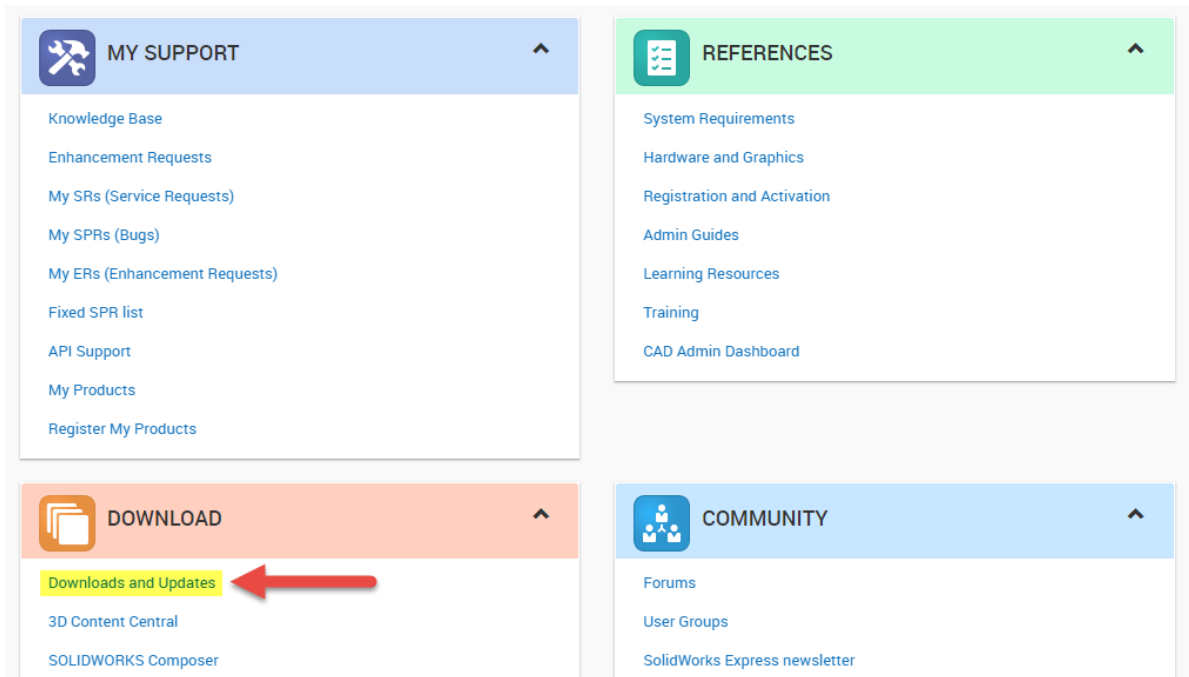

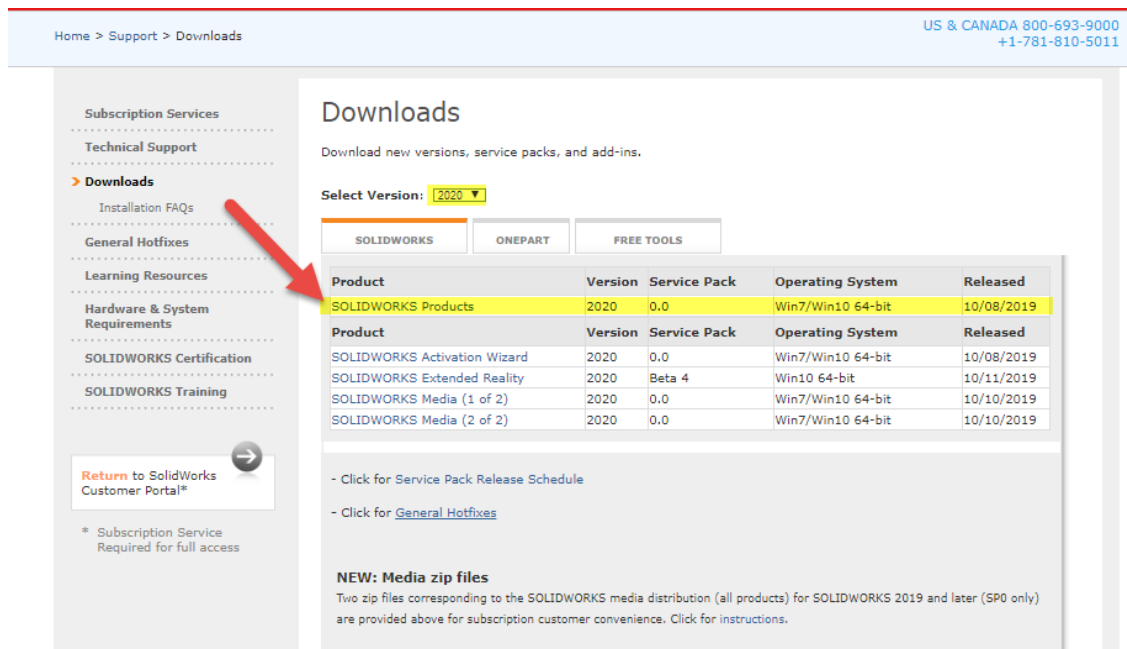


7. Click Downloads and Updates from the Download area.




### Step 2

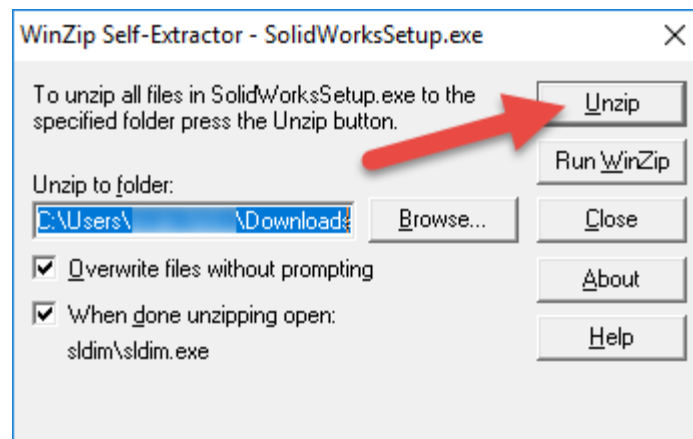

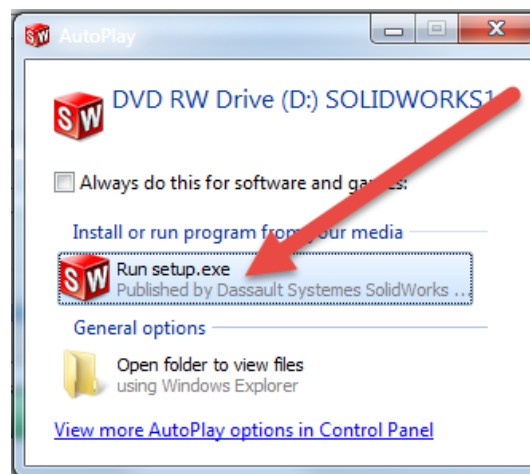

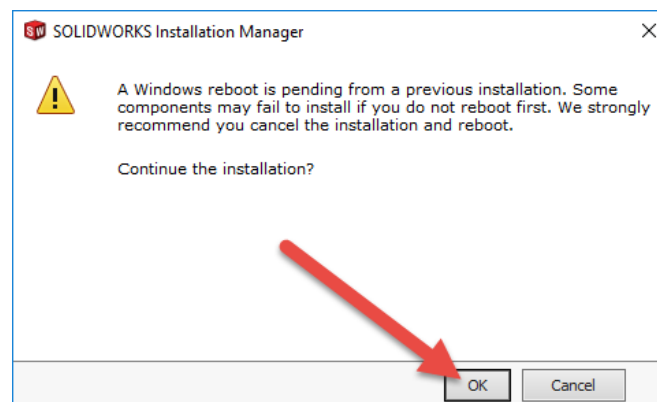
12. Click Unzip. Skip to step 14.



13. If installing from a media disk, click Run setup.exe

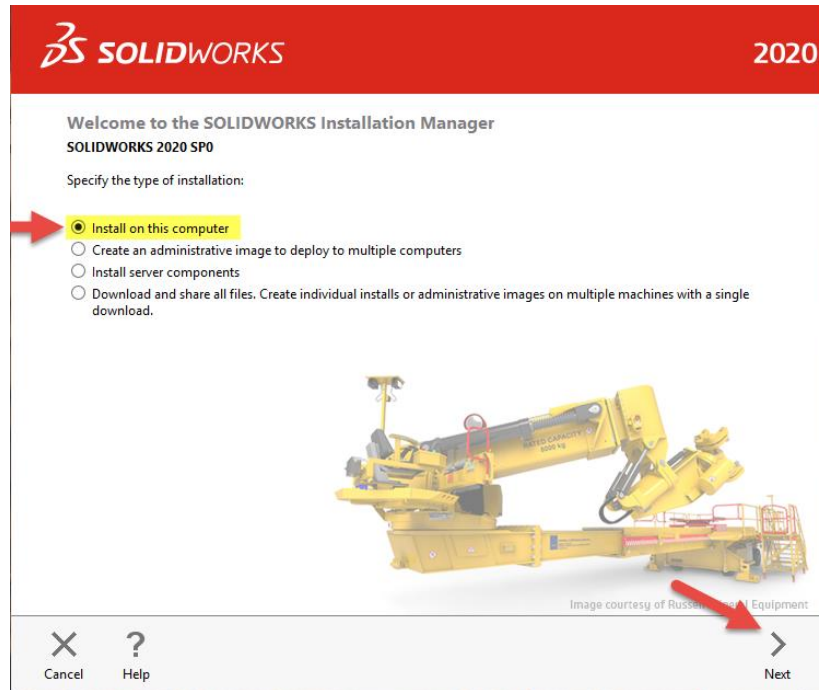


14. If you receive this message, click OK.

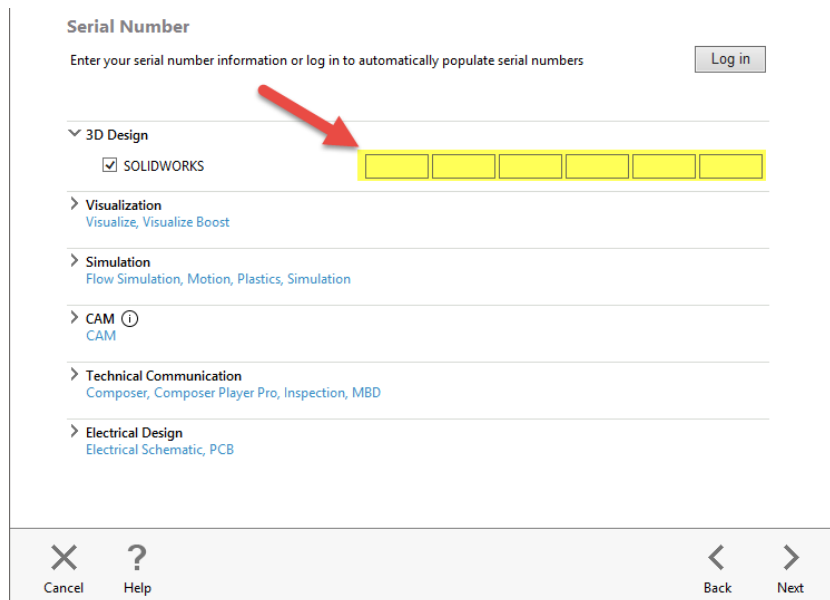




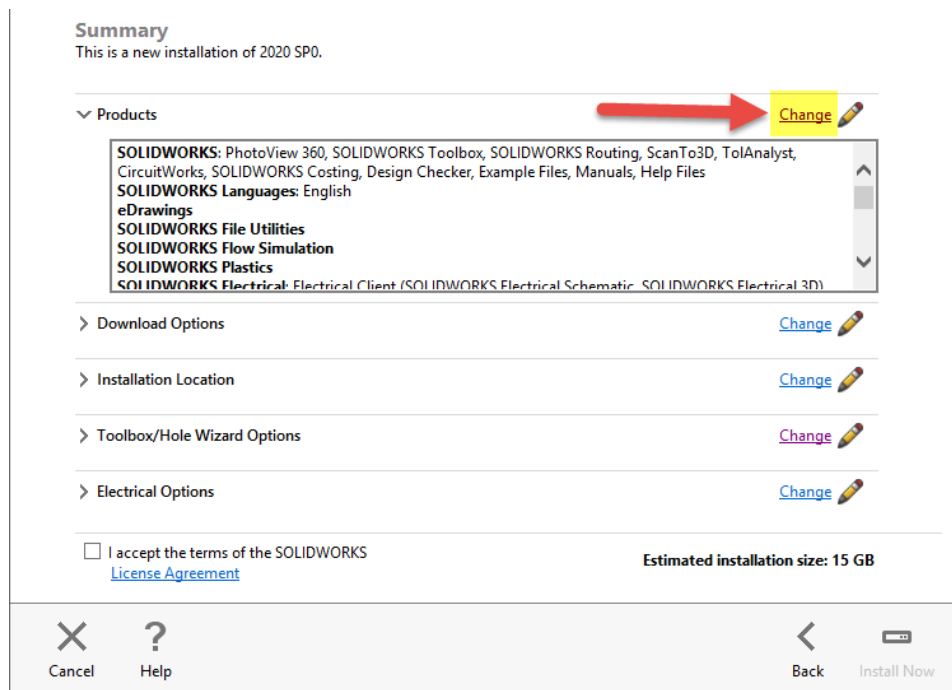
15. Ensure **Install on this computer** is selected for the type of installation and click **Next**.



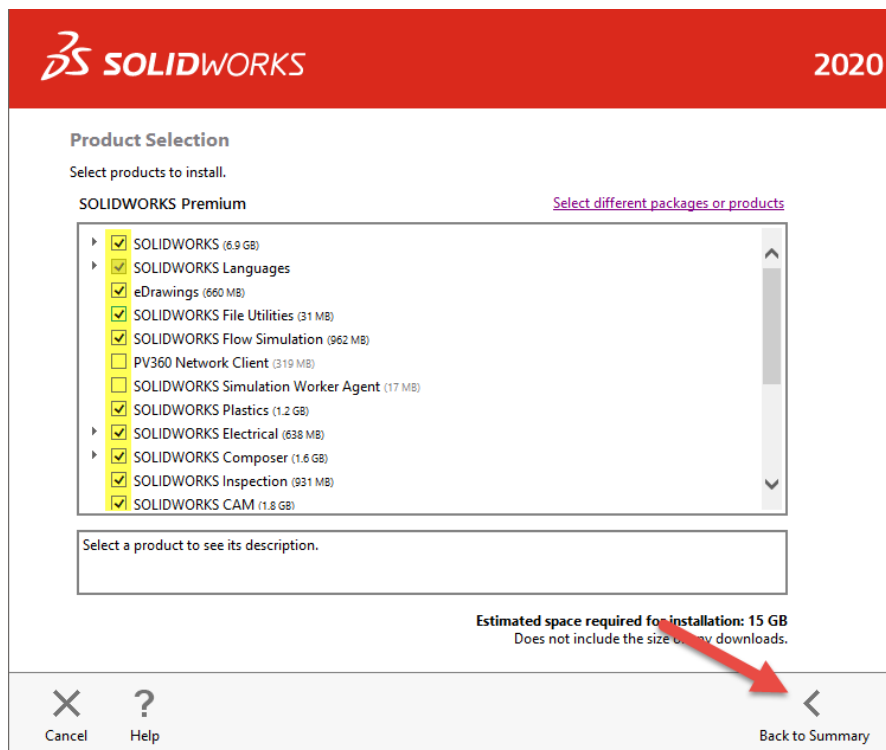
16. Enter your SolidWorks serial number as well as any other serial numbers for products you would like to install, and then click **Next**.




17. Select **Change** to change which products will be installed.



18. Ensure all of the products you wish to install are checked. Then click **Back to Summary**.



19. Adjust any of the other download, installation, or toolbox location settings if needed, otherwise they can be left on their defaults. Accept the terms of SOLIDWORKS. Then click **Install Now**.
